REQUIREMENTS:

GED tests are online and are given in a Pearson Vue testing lab. Students should be familiar with using a computer and possess basic typing skills. Candidates must have an email address. Pearson Vue communicates with candidates via email.

Candidates must register for tests online at <https://ged.com/>

If the candidate needs help, please come to Room 312 at Hawthorne Education Center for assistance. Candidates must pay for the tests with a Credit or Debit card when they are scheduling their tests.

Persons must be **NINETEEN YEARS OF AGE AND A RESIDENT OF MINNESOTA** before they can be permitted to take the tests. If under 19, an age waiver must be obtained from the State of Minnesota. Please call 328-4425 if you have any questions.

A valid Government Issued Picture ID is required for verification of identity and eligibility for testing. **YOU CANNOT TEST WITHOUT ONE!!** This can be a passport, driver's license or ID card. If the ID has expired it cannot be accepted and the candidate cannot test. (Note: An expired driver's license can be accepted ONLY IF it is accompanied by the renewal paperwork!)

DAYTIME TESTING

Daytime testing can be scheduled between 08:45 a.m. until 12:00pm on **Fridays**

EVENING TESTING

Evening testing can be scheduled between 3:30pm until 7:00pm on **Wednesdays**
